Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2021/2022

The following are the date applicable for admission to First Year

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	October 2nd 2020
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	October 30th 2020
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	November 16th 2020
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	December 8th 2020

***Failure to accept an offer with the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Special Class Application and Decision Dates for Admission to 2021/2022

The following are the dates applicable for admission to the school's special class which caters for the children with Autistic Spectrum Disorder-

The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to the special class on	November 27 th 2020
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application for admission to the special class is	December 11 th 2020
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	December 18 th 2020
